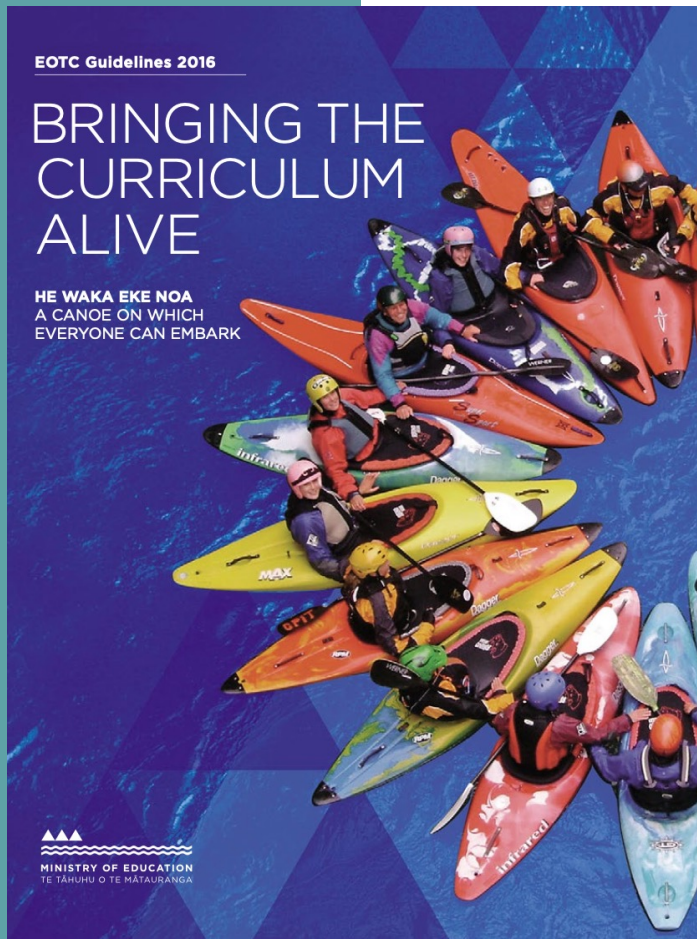

the perspective

- 47,500 students have left school in Germany without a qualification - every year since 2011
- The shortage of teachers has already meant that scientific subjects are not longer taught by qualified teachers in some regions of germany
- More and more interdisciplinary topics such as education for sustainable development, digitalization or dealing with climate change are being taught in schools, without the teachers being appropriately qualified.

My thesis: if extracurricular learning spaces are integrated as an integral part of school education, they can contribute a lot to solving these challenges.
